

Winter Summer is here!

UCPH and DTU are almost open again! The plan for returning to our workplace is still:

14 June: 50 % of staff are allowed back **01 August:** 100 % of staff are allowed back

Copenhagen Jazz Festival \(\mathcal{J}\): Every single summer since 1979 Copenhagen Jazz Festival has taken over Copenhagen as one of Europe's most important international musical events based on eminent artistic quality and a sharp focus on both the new Danish and international jazz scene.

Canal Tours or rent your own little boat and cruise the harbors in Copenhagen! Canal Tours Copenhagen is a wonderful way of seeing Copenhagen. Many Copenhageners take the tour to get an opportunity to see their capital from a different perspective. Experience the idyllic harbors and canals of Copenhagen with a canal tour. The tours are conducted in both Danish and English, and some departures have a third language, varying between German, Italian, French, Portuguese and Spanish. A tour takes approximately one hour.
