## ≧ The Hubertus Hunt ≦

**The Hubertus Hunt** is an annual event that has taken place on the first Sunday in November since the foundation of the Danish Sport Riding Club in the 1900s. This year it will be held on **Sunday the 6<sup>th</sup> of November**. The event is held in *Dyrehaven*, north of Copenhagen, and attracts up to 40,000 spectators and 200 riders. The Hubertus Hunt is a symbolic continuation of the old [par force hunts](#), for which *Dyrehaven* was originally designed. The royal family still attends the spectacle and watches from the Hermitage Hunting Lodge, before presenting the prize to the winner of the hunt. The Hermitage Plain's [unique star-shaped path system](#) was built in the 1680s by King Christian V. On the highest point on the plain is the Hermitage Hunting Lodge, originally known as the Hermitage Castle, built by King Christian VI in 1734.



**The route:** The start is always by Peter Liep's House in the Deer Park, and from there the 13-kilometer wild chase goes through the woods. The fox tails (riders with fox tails, no real fox is chased!) show the way. There are a total of 35 obstacles including the famous and challenging crossing of the pond (where the riders tends to fall into the water).
